APPROVAL OF THE 2021 CONTINUUM OF CARE (COC) GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE US DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, in response to a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for Continuum of Care (CoC) grant published in the Federal Register to supplement funding for local homeless programs, Homeward, formerly known as the Polk County Continuum of Care, Board prepared an application for \$4,433,263 to be submitted to HUD for funds approval; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on October 18, 2021, the Homeward Board received and recommended approval of Homeward's Grant Committee's recommendations for the 2021 CoC grant application; and

WHEREAS, the application is based upon Homeward's strategy to address homelessness in Polk County, whereby CoC funds would provide needed services to homeless persons in Des Moines and throughout Polk County and address high priority service gaps within the parameters of the priorities and procedures recommended by the Homeward Board.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the above referenced CoC program application and certifications thereto are hereby approved and ratified, and the City Manager or his designee is hereby directed to execute any necessary documents and submit the application to HUD.
