AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 34-203, relating to disturbing flowers, trees and animal life in cemeteries.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 34-203, relating to disturbing flowers, trees and animal life in cemeteries, as follows:

Sec. 34-203. Disturbing flowers, trees and animal life.

No person shall remove or injure flowers, either wild or cultivated, or remove, injure or prune trees, shrubbery or plants, except when tending to privately planted flowers, plants, trees or shrubs on a space or plot with permission of the owner. No person, except persons authorized, shall feed, disturb, or remove the birds, fish or other animal life in the cemetery.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
