## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 114-632, relating to the parking of trucks, tractors, trailers and semitrailers in residential districts.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by

Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 114-

632, relating to the parking of trucks, tractors, trailers and semitrailers in residential districts, as

follows:

## Sec. 114-632. Residential districts.

- (a) No person shall park a motor truck having a freight capacity greater than one ton or any trailer, semitrailer, tractor, road tractor or truck tractor unit at any time upon any portion of a street abutting property zoned N-1 to N-5 or NX1 to NX3 occupancy, as defined in chapter 134 of this Code.
- (b) A person who violates any provision of this section shall pay a fine of \$100.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and

publication as provided by law.
