ACCEPTANCE OF AN INCREASE IN FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD GRANT AWARD THROUGH THE OFFICE OF DRUG CONTROL POLICY

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has been awarded an increase in funding for the 2020 Project Safe Neighborhood grant through the Office of Drug Control Policy in the increased amount of \$104,126.50 designated to reimburse overtime related to targeted drug enforcement; and,

WHEREAS, the grant performance period has also been amended to July 13, 2021, through June 30, 2023, with no matching funds requirement.
