ORDINANCE NO.	

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of Birdland Park lying south of and adjoining 1900 Saylor Road.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Sec. 1. That a portion of Birdland Park lying south of and adjoining 1900 Saylor Road, more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated:

THAT PART OF LOT 7 IN THOMPSON ESTATES, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF SECTIONS 26, 27, 28, 34, 35 & 36, TOWNSHIP 79 NORTH, RANGE 24 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT DATED 1866 AND RECORDED IN BOOK A PAGE 192, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

WESTERLY LINE OF SAYLOR ROAD AS MONUMENTED AND OCCUPIED AND A NON-TANGENT CURVE; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG A CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 593.00 FEET, A CHORD BEARING OF SOUTH 25 DEGREES 13 MINUTES 48 SECONDS EAST AND A CHORD LENGTH OF 58.33 FEET, FOR AN ARC LENGTH OF 58.35 FEET TO A POINT OF TANGENCY; THENCE SOUTH 28 DEGREES 02 MINUTES 56 SECONDS EAST ALONG SAID WESTERLY LINE OF SAYLOR ROAD, 225.65 FEET TO A POINT OF CURVATURE; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG SAID WESTERLY LINE BEING A CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A RADIUS OF 523.00 FEET, A CHORD BEARING OF SOUTH 31 DEGREES 19 MINUTES 59 SECONDS EAST AND A CHORD LENGTH OF 59.93 FEET, FOR AN ARC LENGTH OF 59.96 FEET TO A POINT OF TANGENCY; THENCE SOUTH 34 DEGREES 37 MINUTES 02 SECONDS EAST ALONG SAID WESTERLY LINE, 5.54 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, IN AND FORMING A PART OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, POLK COUNTY, IOWA, CONTAINING 31,341 SQUARE FEET.

- Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
