REPROGRAMMING OF PRIOR YEARS' UNSPENT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), INCLUDING COVID RESPONSE FUNDS (CDBG-CV), TO THE 2022 CONSOLIDATED PLAN PROGRAM YEAR AND APPROVAL OF RELATED GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR FUNDING THE CITY'S 2022 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN, OR THIRD YEAR OF THE 2020-2024 CONSOLIDATED PLAN

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-1792, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the proposed 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan, which outlines the City's five-year strategy for use of its entitlement funds such as Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program, and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and authorized the City Manager to submit the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan to HUD; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2021, by Roll Call No. 21-1675, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the proposed 2022 Action Plan, as part of the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan, and authorized and directed the City Manager to submit the 2022 Action Plan with the required SF-424 application forms and required certifications to HUD; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2022, Congress passed the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022, which included HUD's Fiscal Year 2022 appropriations in Public Law 117-103; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2022, HUD's Office of Community Planning and Development issued notice 22-05 instructing formula grantees and HOME Participating Jurisdictions (PJs), such as the City of Des Moines, to submit their 2022 Annual Action Plans when the actual grant amounts have been determined and announced by HUD, which was announced on May 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has reviewed unspent prior year CDBG funding, including CDBG-CV funding, and is recommending that these funds be utilized as set out in the attached council communication and simultaneously administered with the proposed 2022 Annual Action Plan activities; and

WHEREAS, once HUD has received and approved the 2022 Annual Action Plan with the actual grant amounts, HUD will forward three Grant Agreements for \$3,825,560 (CDBG), \$1,106,791 (HOME), and \$326,842 (ESG), which will be on file with the City Clerk and by this reference made a part hereof, which represent grant awards for use in the City's 2022 CDBG, HOME, and ESG programs.
