REALLOCATING \$65,000 FROM THE CITY'S THIRD ROUND OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING TO PREPARE FOR, PREVENT, AND RESPOND TO CORONAVIRUS (CDBG-CV 3) ADMINISTRATION FUNDING TO THE GRUBB Y AFTER SCHOOL CARE AT KING ELEMENTARY

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) was signed into Public Law 116-136, which provides additional Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV) funding to prepare, prevent, and respond to coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2020, HUD allocated the City of Des Moines \$2,231,212 in CDBG-CV and \$1,108,334 in ESG-CV funds for activities to respond to the public health crisis, and on May 4, 2020 by Roll Call No. 20-0792, Council approved said activities to be submitted as the first amendment to the City's 2019 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2020, HUD announced the availability of a second round of \$1 billion in CDBG-CV funds for states and allocated \$9,529,120 in CDBG-CV 2 funds to the State of Iowa to be administered by Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA); and

WHEREAS, IEDA allocated \$2,067,124 CDBG-CV 2 funds to the City of Des Moines, and on September 14, 2020 by Roll Call No. 20-1511, Council approved said activities to be submitted as an application to IEDA to be included in the State of Iowa's Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020, HUD awarded a second ESG-CV allocation to the City of Des Moines in the amount of \$2,081,414 for activities to respond to the public health crisis, and on November 23, 2020 by Roll Call No. 20-1977, Council approved said activities to be submitted as the second amendment to the City's 2019 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2020, HUD awarded a third round of CDBG-CV funds to the City of Des Moines in the amount of \$1,241,887 for activities to respond to the public health crisis, and on March 22, 2021 by Roll Call No. 21-0507 was approved and submitted as the third amendment to the City's 2019 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the cumulative amount of funding allocated under the CARES Act is \$3,473,099 in CDBG-CV funds directly from HUD; \$2,067,124 in CDBG-CV funds from Iowa Economic Development Authority, and \$3,189,748 in ESG-CV funds, or \$7,736,461 total; and

WHEREAS, the City will have unused administration funds from its CDBG-CV 3 allocation; and

WHEREAS, the subrecipient Grubb YMCA has expressed interest in and ability to expend reallocated funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that reallocation of \$65,000 from the CDBG-CV 3 administration activity to Grubb YMCA for its afterschool program at King Elementary is hereby approved.
