APPROVING AGREEMENT WITH THE U. S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FIVE (5) STREAM GAGING STATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached Agreement, in the amount of \$56,720 between the City of Des Moines and the U.S. Geological Survey, which provides for the operation of the City’s five (5) gaging stations, (63rd Street on Walnut Creek, Easton Boulevard on Four Mile Creek, Fleur Drive on the Raccoon River, 63rd Street on the Raccoon River, and 2nd Avenue on the Des Moines River), for which the City of Des Moines will contribute \$37,316, the City of West Des Moines will contribute \$11,941 and the Des Moines Water Works will contribute \$7,463 to cover budgeted costs for the period from October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2023, is hereby approved, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Mayor is authorized and directed to sign such Agreement and the City Clerk to attest to the Mayor’s signature.
