AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 114-3507, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That Section 114-3507, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is amended as follows:

Sec. 114-3507. Mulberry Street--Eighth Street to Ninth Street.

Mulberry Street, on the north side, from Eighth Street to Ninth Street, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Mulberry Street, on the north side, from Eighth Street to a point 40 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Mulberry Street, on the south side, from Eighth Street to Ninth Street, no parking any time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
