SET HEARING FOR APPROVAL OF DOCUMENTS FOR THE VACATION OF ALLEN PARK AS PARKLAND DUE TO THE DES MOINES RIVER LEVEE ALTERATIONS PROJECT – PHASE C

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2020, by Roll Call No. 20-1756, the City Council of the City of Des Moines voted to approve the acquisition of property interests required for the Des Moines River Levee Alterations - Phases B and C Project (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2022, by Roll Call No. 22-1318, the City Council of the City of Des Moines approved the acquisition of property located in the vicinity of Southeast 5th Street and East Titus Avenue, and passed Ordinance No. 22-382 dedicating said property as City parkland; and

WHEREAS, Allen Park, located along the Des Moines River at 800 Southeast 6th Street, will be significantly impacted by the Project, and the City Parks and Recreation Department recommends that the current location be vacated as parkland and Allen Park be relocated to the Southeast 5th Street and East Titus Avenue location; and

WHEREAS, there is no known current public need or benefit for the parkland proposed to be vacated and the City will not be inconvenienced by the vacation of said parkland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

1. That the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, shall consider adoption of an ordinance permanently vacating Allen Park, legally described as follows:

A PART OF VACATED MAURY STREET RIGHT OF WAY, A PART OF BLOCK 66, A PART OF BLOCK 67, A PART OF BLOCK 68, A PART OF VACATED VALE STREET RIGHT OF WAY, ALL IN TOWN OF DE MOINE, AN OFFICIAL PLAT; ALL NOW INCLUDED IN AND FORMING A PART OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, POLK COUNTY, IOWA, AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE WEST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SOUTHEAST 6TH STREET AND THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF VACATED MAURY STREET; THENCE SOUTH ALONG THE SAID WEST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SOUTHEAST 6TH STREET TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHEASTERLY BANK OF THE DES MOINES RIVER; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID BANK TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF VACATED MAURY STREET; THENCE EAST ALONG SAID NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, AND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 2.8 ACRES.

2. That the meeting of the City Council at which the proposed vacation of said parkland and adoption of said ordinance are to be considered shall be on January 23, 2023, said hearing to be held at 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa. At that time, the City Council will consider the above-described proposal and any other(s) submitted prior to or during the public hearing.
