OBLIGATING FUNDS AS PROVIDED IN ARPA LEGISLATION AND RULE AND GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS RELATED TO ARPA FUNDS

WHEREAS, in March of 2021, the United States Government adopted the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) in response to the continuing intertwined public health and economic crisis created by COVID-19 and ARPA established the Cononavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) to provide state, local, and tribal governments with the resources needed to respond to the pandemic and its economic effects and to buid a stroner, more equitable economy during the recovery; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines was allocated and has received funds in the amount of \$94,824,614 from SLFRF (the “ARPA funds”); and,

WHEREAS, purusant to the Final Rule of the United States Department of Treasury, allocations and expnditure of the funds must meet specific purposes and occur within specific time limitations as explained in the Council Communication; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to provide the City Manager and Finance Department with an approved and revised policy providing for the expenditure of the SLFRF funding consistent with the the Final Rule, revising the obligations in Roll Call No. 22-1150, adopted on July 18, 2022 and in Roll Call 22-1817, adopted on November 21, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, ARPA and the Treasury Department Final Rule, 31 CFR Part 35, effective April 1, 2022 (the “ARPA Final Rule”) provides that the City may use the ARPA Funds for provisions of government services to the extent of the reduction in the city’s general revenue due to the public health emergency as provided in, but not limited to, section 35.5(d) of the ARPA Final Rule; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to utilize ARPA funds for such purposes; and,

WHEREAS, additional funds are available to be obligated for other purposes and the City Manager is recommending that he be given the authority to enter into contracts to incur such obligations for ARPA funds and the Mayor and City Council wish to delegate such authority, subject to approval as to form by the Legal Department, to ensure that ARPA funds are timely obligated.
