APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR THE 2025 GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY BUREAU (GTSB) LAW ENFORCEMENT HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$246,333.

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Police Department requests City Council approval for Mayor Boesen and Police Chief Dana Wingert to sign the application for the FY2025 Governor’s Traffic Safety Bureau (GTSB) grant, and;

WHEREAS, the solicited funds will be utilized to raise public awareness of traffic, pedestrian and bicycle safety through overtime, the purchase of traffic enforcement equipment, and officer training, and;

WHEREAS, the application is in the amount of \$246,333, and;

WHEREAS, the grant does not require matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa authorizes the Chief of Police and the Mayor to sign the application for grant funding from the Governor’s Traffic Safety Bureau for fiscal year 2025 with the City Clerk to attest to the Mayor’s signature and the Chief of Police or his designee, is directed to take any and all steps necessary to implement the grant if and when awarded.
