RESOLUTION CONTINUING HEARING ON APPLICATION OF
STEVEN CAIRNS FOR REZONING OF
2717 MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. PARKWAY

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-871, the City Council scheduled a public hearing to be held on June 9, 2008, at 5:00 p.m., on the application of Steven Cairns (tenant) to rezone property owned by AE Farms, Inc., and located at 2717 Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, from "M-3" Limited Industrial District, to a Limited "M-1" Light Industrial District; and,

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-1046, the City Council approved a request by the applicant Steven Cairns to continue the public hearing on the rezoning until June 23, 2008, to allow additional time for discussions with the City Staff regarding the appropriate conditions to be placed upon the future use and development of the property, and,

WHEREAS, in light of the temporary evacuation of City Hall and the relocation of this hearing to temporary facilities in the Central Library Building in response to the recent flooding in the City of Des Moines, the City Council desires to continue the public hearing until the Council and the public can give a more through consideration of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE MOVED by Kiernan to continue the public hearing until July 14, 2008, at 5:00 p.m.
