WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency (DMMHA) administers a Family Self-Sufficiency Program, which is partially funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, staff has prepared a Public Housing Family Self-Sufficiency Grant Application to HUD for \$69,000 of annual funding; and

WHEREAS, receipt of this funding would continue the current program and increase job development services for the Family Self-Sufficiency Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Housing Governing Board of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the submission of the Public Housing Family Self-Sufficiency Program Coordinator Grant Application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon award of this Grant by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Mayor as Chairman of the Municipal Housing Governing Board is hereby authorized to execute the Grant documents and the Executive Director of the DMMHA or his designee is also authorized to execute any related documents and to implement the Grant.
