RESOLUTION DEDICATING RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE EXTENSION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PARKWAY - SOUTHWEST 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET TO SOUTHEAST 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET SEGMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has acquired the necessary right-of-way for, and has completed the construction of, the extension of Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway – Southwest 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to Southeast 9<sup>th</sup> Street Segment; and

WHEREAS, a Plat of Survey has been prepared and recorded that identifies land appropriate for dedication of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

The Plat of Survey recorded in the office of the Polk County Recorder in Book 14139, Pages 432-433 of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway right-of-way is hereby approved, and the parcel of City-owned land described in the said Plat of Survey as dedicated for street purpose is hereby dedicated as public right-of-way, including street and sidewalk as applicable, for Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway.
