WHEREAS, the Engineering Department requested the Finance Department, Procurement Division to solicit bids for an annual contract with up to two (2) additional twelve (12) month renewal options to furnish sign making services for use by the Traffic & Transportation Division and other city departments; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Division solicited bids by advertisement and mailed Invitation to Bid V14-042 to nine (9) potential bidders with two (2) bids received; and

WHEREAS, the overall low dollar compliant bid was received from Iowa Prison Industries, 406 N. High Street, Anamosa, IA 52205 (Al Reiter/Plant Manager), at a total annual estimated cost of \$50,000.00 which is based on unknown quantities related to project and maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from various departmental operating budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the Engineering Department recommend approval of the overall low dollar compliant bid;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the overall low dollar compliant bid for sign making services as submitted by Iowa Prison Industries at a total annual estimated cost of \$50,000.00, and further authorizes the Procurement Administrator to enter into an annual agreement renewable for up to two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods, with price increases complying with agreement terms.
