RESOLUTION CONTINUING MULTIPLE PUBLIC HEARINGS ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED TO BE HELD BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL ON MARCH 23RD AND APRIL 6TH, 2020, TO BE HELD ON APRIL 20, 2020, AT 5:00 PM IN THE SECOND FLOOR BOARD ROOM IN THE RICHARD A. WHEREAS, by a Proclamation issued March 15, 2020, Mayor Cownie determined that a state of emergency or public danger exists within the City of Des Moines as a result of the global spread of the COVID-19 virus, and declared that all gatherings of 250 people or more on public property or public right-of-way are prohibited; and,

WHEREAS, by a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency issued March 17, 2020, Governor Kimberly K. Reynolds proclaimed a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency exists throughout the entire state of Iowa, and ordered that that "Social, community, spiritual, religious, recreational, leisure, and sporting gatherings and events of more than 10 people are prohibited at all locations and venues, including but not limited to parades, festivals, conventions, and fundraisers"; and,

WHEREAS, by a Proclamation Amendment issued March 17, 2020, Mayor Cownie determined that the state of emergency or public danger determined to exist in his prior Proclamation still exists and he amended the Proclamation to prohibit all gatherings of 10 people or more on public property or public right-of-way; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council is scheduled to hold a number of public hearings on March 23rd and April 6th that cannot be held on these dates pursuant to the Mayor's Proclamation of March 15, 2020, as amended by the Proclamation Amendment of March 17, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

1. The following public hearings previously scheduled to be heard by the City Council on March 23rd or April 6th, 2020, are hereby continued to April 20, 2020, at 5:00 pm in the Second Floor Board Room in the Richard A.
