AUTHORIZE STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS TO RE-DESIGNATE THE 6TH AVENUE CORRIDOR FOR THE IOWA GREAT PLACES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2014, by Roll Call No. 14-1642, the City Council authorized submittal of an Iowa Great Places Program Grant application for improving Des Moines' commercial corridors with streetscape enhancements along 6th Avenue and 42nd Street; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-0403, the City Council approved an Iowa Great Places Program Grant Agreement for Phase 1 of the 6th Avenue Corridor Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the 6th Avenue Streetscape project is bound by Hickman Avenue on the north and College Avenue on the south; and

WHEREAS, the 6th Avenue Corridor is due to be re-designated under the Iowa Great Places Program; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to apply for re-designation to the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs and the Iowa Great Places Program is June 15, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the Mayor or City Manager are hereby authorized and directed to submit an application to the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs and the Iowa Great Places Program to re-designation the 6th Avenue Corridor as an Iowa Great Place.
