APPROVAL OF REPROGRAMMING OF UNSPENT EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) FUNDING TO CENTRAL IOWA SHELTER & SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines receives annual Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) entitlement funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2018 by roll call 18-0997 the City Council approved the 2018 ESG funding; and

WHEREAS, \$44,538.84 in unspent funding remains from the 2018 ESG funding and is available for reprogramming; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2019, the City Council approved the 2020 Action Plan based on funding estimates; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2020, HUD announced the City's funding allocations for the 2020 ESG funding; and

WHEREAS, \$7,275 in unallocated funding is available for reprogramming; and

WHEREAS, Central Iowa Shelter & Services provides emergency shelter service for Des Moines and relocated some of its clients from the shelter to a hotel to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. The \$44,538.84 in 2018 unspent ESG funding and the \$7,275 in 2020 unallocated ESG funding be allocated to Central Iowa Shelter & Services to reimburse for expenses of relocating their clients to hotels to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
2. Consistent with Roll Call No. 96-1034, dated March 18, 1996, regarding contract and amendment procedures for ESG funded projects, the City Council authorizes and directs the City Manager to approve and execute the detailed work program and written agreements with the awarded nonprofit agency and governmental entity; to approve and execute necessary amendments to the work programs and written agreements that do not involve any substantive change in location, level of service, time period, budget or project purpose; and to submit all proposed amendments to the work programs and written agreements entities that are not in accordance with the City Council approval of the Consolidated Plan and the projects listed therein, or that constitute a substantive change in the location, level of service, time period, budget or project purpose, to the City Council for review, consideration and approval.
