**RESOLUTION WITH RESPECT TO PUBLIC HEARING ON
THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$50,500,000 GENERAL
OBLIGATION URBAN RENEWAL BONDS FOR ESSENTIAL
CORPORATE URBAN RENEWAL PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 384.25 and 403.12 of the City Code of Iowa, notice of the hearing on the issuance of not to exceed \$50,500,000 General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds and the proposed action by the City Council to institute proceedings for the issuance of said Bonds has been given for the purpose of paying costs of aiding in the planning, undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects in accordance with Iowa Code chapter 403 and the urban renewal plans for the Central Place Industrial Park Redevelopment Program Urban Renewal Area, Ingersoll-Grand Commercial Urban Renewal Area, Metro Center Urban Renewal Area, and SE Agribusiness Urban Renewal Area, as amended, including the Animal Control Facility project, the Municipal Services Center project, and various public improvement projects involving street, streetscape, bridge, sidewalk, skywalk, and utility improvements, with related site improvements, and that notice of the proposal to issue the Bonds and the right to petition for an election had been published as provided by Sections 384.24(3(q), 384.25 and 403.12 of the Code of Iowa, and the Mayor then asked the City Clerk whether any petition had been filed in the Clerk's Office, as contemplated in Section 362.4 of the Code of Iowa, and the Clerk reported that no such petition had been filed, requesting that the question of issuing the Bonds be submitted to the qualified electors of the City.

WHEREAS, a public meeting was duly held at the time and place provided and in accordance with said notice, said meeting being reconvened to the date hereof, at which oral or written objections were received and filed, including the following:

No written objections; no oral legal objections or challenges to the bond proceedings; several comments made with respect to funding priorities of the City, including those relating to the police department.



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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

That the time for receiving oral and written objections be closed and the proposal for the issuance of said Bonds and all objections thereto are taken under consideration by the Council.
