REALLOCATION OF PRIOR YEARS' UNSPENT EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) FUNDING UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018, the City received several applications and requests for Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for program years 2019 and 2020; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-0290, the Council approved ESG funding allocations to five subrecipients, including:

- Hawthorn Hill, Central Iowa Shelter & Services, Iowa Homeless Youth Center, Primary Health Care, and Iowa Institute for Community Alliances; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2020, by Roll Call No. 20-1224, the Council approved a continuation of the 2019 allocations with the 2020 ESG funding to the aforementioned five subrecipients; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$16,042.40 in ESG funds from program years 2019 and 2020 is unspent and it is recommended that these funds be reallocated to Hawthorn Hill as outlined in the attached Council Communication.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the recommendations regarding the utilization of unspent prior years ESG funding as set out in Council Communication No. 21-203 are hereby approved.
