WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (k) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from supply schedules established by the State of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Paint is being purchased Diamond Vogel Paint, PO Box 380, Orange City, IA 51041 (OWNER), in the amount of \$70,000.00 utilizing the State of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) purchasing contract number 7697; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from 2021-22 Operating Budget, page 61, Engineering Department, Traffic and Transportation—Sign, Painting, Signal and Lighting, EG062080.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, accepts and approves the purchase and installation of Traffic Paint from Diamond Vogel Paint in the total amount of \$70,000.00 using State of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) purchasing contract number 7697.
