RECEIVE AND FILE COMMUNICATION FROM THE PLAN AND ZONING COMMISSION REGARDING REQUEST FROM THE SALVATION ARMY FOR VACATION OF A REMAINING EAST-TO-WEST ALLEY SEGMENT TO THE WEST OF EAST 3RD STREET IN THE BLOCK BETWEEN EAST COURT AVENUE AND EAST MARKET STREET

WHEREAS, the City Plan and Zoning Commission has advised that at a public hearing held on March 17, 2022, its members voted 10-0 to recommend APPROVAL of a request from the Salvation Army (owner), represented by Bramwell E. Higgins (officer) to vacate a remaining east-to-west alley segment to the west of East 3rd Street between East Court Avenue and East Market Street, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for any existing utilities until such time that they are abandoned or relocated at the applicant's expense. The adjoining properties to the North, West, and South are owned by the Salvation Army.
