APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR THE 2022 BODY-WORN CAMERA POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM TO SUPPORT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines will submit an application for funding from the 2022 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Law Enforcement Agencies grant through the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$8,330 for the purchase of additional body-worn cameras equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the grant if awarded will fund up to \$2,000 per camera system with a match requirement of 50%; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that an application may be submitted for the 2022 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Law Enforcement Agencies through the U.S. Department of Justice with the Mayor or his designee authorized to sign the grant application documents on behalf of the City and allow the City Manager or his designee to submit and carry out the terms of the said grant application in a timely manner.
